Dear Families,

Genesee Health System is happy to have an additional resource available to you to help with any attendance issues you may be having. The Attendance Support Alliance is a program where a mental health screen is being offered to any youth and their families in Genesee County that may be in need of mental health services.

The purpose of the Attendance Support Alliance is to meet with youth who are struggling with school attendance. You would meet with the Diversion Coach, who is a master's level clinician, who will complete a voluntary mental health screen during an appointment and share the results with the youth and yourself. The screening results will include recommendations and assistance in getting into services if needed.

Following the referral and screening, you and your child will be connected with local services to best fit your individual needs. Families are not obligated to follow through with recommendations and the Diversion Coach will be available for follow up with youth, families, and schools.


