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What is Math Lab?

This class will utilize ALEKS which is an online learning and assessment system that identifies instructional gaps and instructs students on topics they are most ready to learn. The course will also include pre-teaching for their Algebra or Geometry class, assignment help (homework completion), and small group instruction.

What materials do I need?

- ALEKS Notebook (provided)
- Chromebook and Charger
- Pencils

Will there be homework?

No! But you must use your class time wisely every day! You may have ALEKS to do at home if you are absent or behind on topics or time.



How can I be successful?

- Be on time and try your best not be absent.
- Use your class time wisely!
- When you arrive get your calculator, put up or put away phone, get out ALEKS notebook.
