Year	Inventor	Invention	Interesting Fact
1872	Elijah McCoy	steam engine lubricator	His products were so respected that customers were known to ask, "Is this the real McCoy?" He earned 42 patents in his lifetime.
1875	A. P. Ashbourne	biscuit cutter	He also invented a process for treating coconut.
1885	Sarah S. Goode	folding cabinet bed	The bed could be used as a desk. Goode invented the bed for people living in small apartments.
1892	Sarah Boone	improved ironing board	The narrow, curved board was designed to iron the sleeves and bodies of ladies' clothes.
1896	Charles B. Brooks	street sweeper truck	Before Brooks invented the truck, streets were cleaned by horse-drawn machines or walking workers who picked up trash by hand or broom.
1897	John Lee Love	portable pencil sharpener	Love's sharpener is the same that many artists use today. The pencil is rotated by hand in the sharpener, with the shavings staying inside.
1905	Madame C. J. Walker	conditioning treatment for straightening hair	Once a poor laundress, she progressed to become the first black woman millionaire as a result of her inventions.
1922	Jack Johnson	a wrench	Not only was he an inventor, but Jack Johnson was also the world's first Black American heavyweight champion.
1923	Garrett Morgan	traffic signal	Because it was common for bicycles, animal-driven wagons, and cars to share the road, there were often accidents. After witnessing one, Garrett Morgan decided to do something to improve safety.
1988	Lonnie Johnson	Super Soaker	Originally named the Power Drencher, it was the first water squirter to include air pressure in its design.
